


# Page editor

You can access the page editor by double-clicking on an existing page in the course content editor.

The page editor can be divided into the following areas: 

## 1) Page settings

Double-click or use the cogwheel icon to access the corresponding page settings.


## 2) Page layout

The page structure in the page editor follows the A-B-C structure. Each page consists of **articles**, **blocks** and **components**.

## 3) Display settings

In this area you can select whether you want to display all items expanded or collapsed.

## A-B-C structure

			
A	<b>Article</b>	Top level, comparable to "Heading 1" in Microsoft Word. Used to divide long pages into coherent sections.	
B	<b>Block</b>	The components are arranged within a block. One full-width component or two half-width components can be inserted per block.	
C	<b>Component</b>	Content and question components can be inserted. For an overview of all components and how to insert a component, see section Components.	

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
